Job requirements include but not limited to: Administrative work, Incident Command, preparation of pre-incident surveys, responsible for the operation and maintenance of fire apparatus, budget preparation, reporting and answering to the township board and ensuring that reports are completed.

- Michigan Certified Company Officer or Officer 1 and 2
- NIMS 100, 200, 700
- Hazardous Materials Awareness & Operations

Recommended would be previous command experience, Fire Officer 3 and NIMS 300, 400 and 800.
